Here is what I have on the amber timing changing. The first attachment "compliance" is merely the schedule for implementation. The attachment labeled "narrative" is the excerpt from the MUTCD. The last attachment is the tables. You can see the amber timings are now determined by whether or not you have a traffic survey conducted and if not, you have to add from 7 to 10 mph to the posted speed and go by the bottom table. Finally, they committee omitted the section that provide a minimum 3 second amber for protected turns. They had a meeting in the beginning of September to put it back in, however, they stated it was already referred to in the MUTCD and they will be leaving that up to the Cities. We are recommending City engineer involvement in these changes. Also, CalTrans approaches should have already been changed but I have heard that some CT think this can wait until the end of next calendar year. We have no information regarding a delay to the implementation.







Captain-

As of 1015 hrs this morning (11-19-15) the enforcement at John Daly/Sheffield (DAL-JDSH-01) has been disabled. The system is set in a manner to only take an A Scene image but no other images or video. Our importer will reject these incidents due to the missing images so we will not have to worry about them going to court or even being processed. All flashes have been disabled also. This way, you can still get statistical data if needed in the future, without the risk of one of these incidents going to court.

I have attached the spreadsheet showing all of the John Daly/Sheffield citations that have been filed with the courts from 8-1-15 until today. The report includes the time in red for each violation. I have added filters to the report so it may be filtered to only display the times/incidents you want to dismiss. I had her include all of the incidents because if you needed the data you would have it and can filter out what you do not wish to see.

To answer your questions:

Is it possible for you to auto dismiss any citations from that intersection that have not been dismissed? We can only reject in bulk for a specific timeframe. However, if you identify which incidents you want dismissed from the attached spreadsheet, I can have my helpdesk open a service order and they would be dismissed by our IT in the back office. The time it takes for this to be finalized would depend on their workload. I can expedite it by getting my Director to approve the highest priority. The only other option I can think of is having Russ or Richard dismiss each one in the SmartOps web application like they currently do. This will be quite time consuming.



Also any citations that are issued between the time we requested the camera be shut down and the time it is actually shut down?

There were no incidents uploaded during the time you requested the shutdown and the time we actually terminated enforcement this morning. This approach lost comms causing the incidents to be stored on the site but not sent to Arizona. When we re-enable the enforcement these incidents will be too old and not be able to be processed.

This notice is to advise you that in the interest of justice, the Daly City Police Department has requested the dismissal of the above listed citation by the Superior Court of California, County of San Mateo.

The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) defines the standards used by traffic engineers nationwide to install and maintain traffic control devices on all public streets and highways. The MUTCD required new minimum yellow light timing intervals standards for intersections with Automated Photo Enforcement that went into effect on August 1, 2015.

The Daly City Police Department discovered the yellow light interval for the approach on eastbound John Daly Blvd at Sheffield Dr. was 0.4 seconds out of compliance between August 1, 2015 and November 19, 2015. Enforcement at this approach was suspended on November 19, 2015. We have since corrected the yellow light timing intervals and are now in compliance with the California MUTCD 2014 standards for these and all Automated Photo Enforcement intersections in the City of Daly City.

Any fines, penalties or fees you have paid to the Superior Court for this citation will be refunded to you and the California Department of Motor Vehicles will be contacted to remove the violation from your record, if a conviction has been reported. It may take up to 60 days for the court to process your refund. Please do not contact the Court to inquire about the status of a refund as such calls will likely divert staff from the work needed to process dismissals and refunds.

If you have an upcoming scheduled traffic arraignment or court trial date for this citation, that date will be vacated and you will not need to appear in court. There is nothing further you need to do to address this citation.
